Fellow District 13 OH1 Lions,

I want to thank all Lions in District 13 OH1 that participated in the 2018 Club Officer Training on April 7th. It was a spectacular Training with a lot of fun, fellowship, and learning. I know all that attended went home having learned something new from the training. Thank you to all Lions that took a few hours out of your busy Saturday morning to participate. Through your leadership and dedication, your clubs will continue to grow and be successful. If your officers were not able to attend this year, we hold this event every year around April/May, and hopefully you will be able to attend in the future. I would like to thank the Holgate Lions Club for hosting our Club Officer Training this year at St. John's Lutheran Church.

This was the most successful Officer Training that we have had in many years. We had a total of 17 clubs from the district participate, which is equivalent to 29% of our clubs. That was up by 7% from last year's Club Officer Training. We had a total of 54 Club Officers from the district participate, which is equivalent to 23% of all the Club Officers within the district. That was up by 8% from last year's Club Officer Training. Club Presidents/Vice Presidents almost doubled from last year's attendance, and Club Treasurers tripled in attendance from last year.

Again, thank you all for a great Club Officer Training, and I hope we can continue the trend upwards for next year and years beyond.




